WHAT TO PRAY FOR:

A

AWAKENING: The 2nd Great Awakening of NZ & massive harvest of people discovering Jesus

W

WITNESS ENCOUNTER: The presence & love of God filling every street with healing & supernatural

A

ADOPT STREETS: Every street marked for Heaven with persons of peace and homes opening up

K

KINDLE FIRE: Capture God's heart for your community: "Break my heart for what breaks Yours, God."

E

EXPAND GROUPS: Pray for thousands of multiplying disciple-making groups across Aotearoa - people discovering Jesus and helping others follow Him.

N

NO DARKNESS: Break addictions & spiritual warfare to bind evil spirits & release Heaven

FAQ'S / Tips:

WHAT DOES A PRAYER WALK LOOK LIKE TO AN OBSERVER?

2 friends going for a walk and talking normally together.

It doesn't need to look weird.

HOW DO I ASK SOMEONE TO JOIN ME?

Prayer walking is simple & looks natural. Anyone can do it.

Ask something like, "Would you like to come with me? Let's go together."

HOW DO I EMPOWER SOMEONE I'VE BEEN PRAYING WITH TO START THEIR OWN PRAYER WALK / DRIVE?

At the end of a prayer walk, ask your prayer partner something like,

*"That wasn't too hard, right? Who could **you** do this with?"*

HOW MANY PEOPLE ON A PRAYER WALK / DRIVE?

For a walk - 2 is ideal. 3 is okay. 4 is too many, but if 4 or more show up, celebrate multiplication! Multiply in to 2 or more teams.

*For a car - you can fit more. **No one goes alone.***

HOW DO I PRAY?

- *As a beloved son or daughter of God, praying from Heaven towards Earth.*
- *Follow the leading of the Holy Spirit & be aware of His presence*
- *Keep it simple. Chat. Walk. Pray simply so others can learn and do it too (if it's too complex, it won't multiply).*

WHAT DO I SAY IF I'M ASKED WHAT I'M DOING?

Don't be shy. Don't use Christianese language. Simply say, "We're praying (or "in karakia") for this neighbourhood, praying for the families on this street".

Offer to pray for them if their body language is receptive.

Use **BURNING**
ARROWS and record every street.
